

## Rules and Guidelines – EEB3 Bal du Bac 2026

Obeying the following rules and regulations will ensure a safe night for everyone.

Please note that, if they are not followed, entry will be denied to you or you will be removed from the venue.

**\*If you, the participant, are under the age of 18 years old, your parent/guardian accepts full responsibility for your actions during the event and on the bus provided by the Bal du Bac Committee returning to Brussels afterwards.**

**By participating in the event of the Bal du Bac<sup>1</sup> you, the participant, agree to follow the rules below:**

1. There will be photographers present. The participant may appear in photos taken at the event and hereby accepts that the organisers may use these pictures on social media and other publications
2. Arriving drunk or under the influence of drugs at the event will give the guards and organisers the right to deny entry.
3. The participant is responsible for any damages or harm caused to the venue, the bus supplied by the Bal du Bac Committee returning to Brussels after the event, or other participants. They will be expected to make amends, potentially in the form of payment to the owners of the venue or the bus company, or any other type of liability resulting from the damages caused and which is not covered by insurance.
4. Participants are required to bring the bracelet already given to them and their booking confirmation demonstrating the purchase of the tickets. No tickets will be sold at the entrance.
5. The participant agrees to respect a formal/chic dress code. If they are not dressed appropriately, they will be denied access to the venue with no reimbursement.
6. The participant agrees that overconsumption of alcohol or the consumption of illicit recreational drugs is their own responsibility as it may cause damage to themselves, other event attendees, the venue itself, or the bus afterwards for which they hereby declare their readiness to refund and/or repair any damage caused. The participant is also aware that the party can be shut down in advance if the Bal du Bac Rules are disrespected.
7. The participant agrees to behave appropriately (avoid excessive drinking, violent behaviour); otherwise Security will exclude them from the event or the bus afterwards.
8. The organisers (and the Bal du Bac Committee itself) can in no way be held accountable for any of the participants' lost or stolen items during the event or on the bus afterwards.
